Canyoning involves rappelling and descending cliffs and waterfalls within the canyon. The Canyoning site is located in Calle Chirracá, a small, modest, yet lush place near our own Turrialba.

We begin the Canyoning tour with an introduction of our guides and the equipment to help familiarize you with the different uses of the equipment. We start the tour at the first waterfall where a guide will give a speech on safety.



This region, known as the Guayabo National Monument is the most important archeological site in Costa Rica and its only monument called Nacional. In Guayabo archeological structures such as roads, mounds, bridges, collection tanks and aqueducts are protected. In addition, it protects patches of evergreen tall forests typical of premontane rainforest.

On your tour with a guide you will be taken throughout the park, while explaining the findings of the excavations and the history of the people who lived there in the past.

A guide will take you on a stroll through CATIE special Botanical Garden where you will find the century old kapok tree, towering stalks of bamboo, dripping orchids and bromeliads form the trees and many other colorful and fruiting plants.
